Veterinary Report

Horse: Lady Of Camelot (AUS), 4yo Bay Thoroughbred Mare

On 12 May 2026 Lady Of Camelot sustained a wound to the palmarolateral aspect of the left fore fetlock during a trip to the beach. The wound was found to communicate with the digital flexor tendon sheath. No lameness was noted at the walk and the mare was referred to The University of Queensland Equine Veterinary Hospital where the tenoscopic lavage was performed and the wounded debrided. Lady of Camelot was placed on a course of anti-microbials and anti-inflammatories. Lady Of Camelot improved daily while remaining under care at Queensland Equine Veterinary Hospital and was discharged on 26 May 2026.

Lady Of Camelot has done very well since returning to Newgate Farm and has been sound with no ill effects from the surgery. The above condition and procedure is unlikely to have any long term effect to Lady Of Camelot.
